





FIT AND SECURE

Taking into account the length and width of your tent, choose where you'd like to position it on the rack. This will determine where you need to fit the Mount Brackets (Items 1 & 2).




Where possible use the combined slats to mount the brackets. If this is not possible then a slat with a leg or foot installed.

Loosely fit the Mount Brackets to the rack using M8 x 20 Hex Bolts, M8 x 16 x 1.6SS Flat Washers and M8 Nyloc Nuts (Items 10, 11 & 12). Note the position of the Mount Brackets and the Latch orientation.

Make sure that the closed side of the Mount Brackets are facing toward the front of the rack and that they are parallel to the side of the rack.




Measure the distance between the center points of the Rack Mount Brackets. You will need this measurement for fitting the Latch Bracket assembly to the tent channel in Step 2.6.

For larger & heavier tents stagger the tent mounting brackets as shown.

2LH Left Hand Mount




Extra Mounting Brackets may be required for some tent and rack combinations.



The Tent Channel Nut Plate included were designed for the Front Runner Tent but will also work with other popular tents. Check your mounting channel measurements for the appropriate size.



Hard shell tents may need additional support. If you are using these brackets with hard shell tents, such as James Baroud, iKamper & Autohome, and you are unable to position the tent to rest directly on the rack side profiles (A), use TBMK009 – Hard Shell Tent Support Channels - by Front Runner (B) sold separately.

Depending on the tent manufacturer, your hard shell tent warranty may be voided if your tent becomes damaged and you did not provide proper lateral support for the hard shell tent.


Flip your tent over to access the mounting channels

Loosely fit the latch bracket assembly (Item 4) by sliding the channel nut plate (Item 3) into the mounting channel and fastening with (Items 5, 6, 7, 8 & 9) as shown. Make sure the bobbins (Item 8) are facing towards the front of the rack as shown.



Measure the distance between the centers of Channel Feet to make sure it matches the position of the Rack Mount Brackets installed in Step 2.2.

Once measurements have been confirmed, fully tighten the Latch Bracket Assembly to the tent channel.

Flip the tent over and lower it onto the rack making sure the Bobbins align with the Rack Mount Brackets.

Push the tent forward so that the Guide Bolts slide fully into the Rack Mount Brackets.

Latch all 4 Latches to secure the tent into the brackets.
