
A complete kit will contain:




FIT AND SECURE



Assemble the Pro Bed Leg (Item 1) to the Front mounting bracket (Item 3) using 4x M8x20 Button head screw and 4x M8 Nyloc Nut (Item 7 & 8) as shown and 2x M8x16 Button head screw and 2x M8 nyloc Nut (Item 6 & 8).

> Do this on both the LH and RH side **DO NOT FULLY TIGHTEN**




Assemble the Front diagonal and Horizontal Brace parts as shown (Item 4, 5 & 6) to the legs assembeled in 2.1 using the 8 x M8 x 20 Button head bolts 8 x M8 x 19 x 2 flat washer and 8 x M8 nyloc nuts (Item 10, 11 & 12).

DO NOT FULLY TIGHTEN.

Use the 12 x M6 x 20 Button Head bolts 12 x M6 x 12 x 1 Flat Washer and 12 x M6 Nyloc Nut (Item 8,17 & 18) to fit the Front Center Brace to th LH and RH Front Horizontal Braces (Item 16).

DO NOT FULLY TIGHTEN.




- Using the supplied 6" T30 torx bit and a cordless driver assemble the extrusion using the M6x25 thread forming screws (Item 19). Use a slow and constant speed when using the cordless driver.
- ⚠ Take note of extrusion orientation!

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Æ Use a little anti seize or oil on screw threads before inserting. Note these are Thread Forming Screws.

Tightening Torque 6-10Nm / 18.4 ft lbs

2 FIT AND SECURE




With the help of a Friend lift the Pro Bed Rack onto the Load bin.

With the Pro Bed rack in Position loosely fit the $2x M8 \times 30$ Button Head screw and $2x M8 \times 19 \times 2$ Flat washers (Item 4 & 11) to the bottom 2 holes in the bracket.

Loosely fit the 1x M8 x 25 Button Head screw and 1x M8 x 19 x 2 flat washer (Item 11 & 12) to the top mounting Hole.


Do this both LH and RH side. DO NOT FULLY TIGHTEN.




Assemble the Pro Bed Rack Leg (Item 1) to the rear top main bracket (Item 2) using the rear gusset (item 3) and 4 x M8x16 Button head screw and 4 x M8 nyloc Nut as shown.

Assemble the 1x M8x20 Button head screw and 1x M8 Nyloc Nut (Item 7&5) and fully tighten all the bolts.

Do this both LH and RH, DO NOT FULLY TIGHTEN.



Loosely assemble the rear top truss using the 3x M8x20 Button head screws,3x M8x19x2 Flat washer and 3x M8 Nyloc Nuts (Item 10,11&12).Fully tighten the M8 Button Heads and place M8 Nut Caps on the M8 Nyloc Nuts (Item 13).



Attach the rear leg assembly to the Extrusions using the M6x25 thread forming screws (Item 19) and a cordless driver. The front assembly will be pulled back into its final position while fully tightening these screws


Loosely fit the 4x M8 x 30 Button Head Screws, 4x M8 x 19 x 2 Flat washer and the 4x 10mm Spacer (Item 4,11 & 16).

Do this both LH and RH side.

Use a little anti seize or oil on screw threads before inserting. Note these are Thread Forming Screws.

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Tightening Torque 6-10Nm / 18.4 ft lbs




Using clamps and a spirit level clamp the spirit level to the inside of the Front Center Brace and Tighten the M6x20 Button head screws and M6 Nyloc Nuts fitted in 2.3.

Place M6 Nut caps on the M6 Nyloc Nuts.

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Tightening Torque:

M6: 8-10Nm / 5.9 ft lb - 7.38 ft lb




Assemble the Rear Wing Brackets (Item 3) using the 3x M6x12 Button head screws and 3x M6 Nyloc Nuts (Item 14 & 8).


Place the 3x M6 Nut caps (Item 9) over the nyloc nuts.

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Tightening Torque:

M6: 8-10Nm / 5.9 ft lb - 7.38 ft lb
